


Recruitment Registration Support

Our registration support package is for General Practices that source their own candidates from overseas but need help with the registration process.

- Application for an initial provider number from Medicare (through the RACGP)
- Application for the relevant 19AB exemption
- Support to the clinic and the candidate for the visa process
- Specialist registration with the Medical Board of Australia (via AHPRA)
- Application for a TFN/ABN
- Support from our accountant with setting up an Australian business entity (as required)
- Access to discounted medical indemnity insurance (as required)



About the registration process

The length of the registration process varies depending on several factors such as:

- The time of year (all processes are likely to take longer over the period from mid-December to late February).
- Recent changes that may be in the process of implementation and therefore take longer than necessary.
- The responsiveness of individual candidates and their ability to process application forms quickly.

However, we find that most candidates can complete the entire process within 6 to 9 months. For those who are onshore for part or all the process, the process may be shorter by several weeks.

Our deliverables

- Changes to the registration process occur frequently and often without notification. As a result, we cannot make assurances on behalf of any processes for any of the statutory bodies (eg. AMC, AHPRA,



Medicare. Department of Home Affairs). We will, however, ensure that we will use our best efforts to keep abreast of changes and to provide updated information as soon as it is available.

- All registration fees payable to statutory bodies are payable by the applicant/candidate and are not included in our consulting fees.
- Visa sponsorship fees payable to the Department of the Home Affairs must be covered by sponsors and will not be covered by our consulting fees.

Costs

- Our registration support service costs \$12,000 plus GST.
- To initiate the service, 50% of this fee is due now with the remaining 50% due within 6 months.
- If the GP changes their mind and no longer requires the service, payment of the second instalment of \$6000 is not required, however we require 14 days notice prior to the 6 month anniversary of the service.
- Should you only require assistance with specific sections, this can be provided for a reduced price and will be quoted individually.
